To obtain a Sight for Students gift certificate you must meet certain qualifications

- The family's income is no more than 200% of the federal poverty level

2017 Federal Poverty Guidelines

- The child is not enrolled in Medicaid or other vision insurance
- The child is 18 years or younger and has not graduated from high school
- The child or parent is a U.S. citizen or legal immigrant with a social security number
- The child has not used the Sight for Students program during the past 12 months

If a child is eligible, the community partner will issue a Sight for Students gift certificate along with a list of VSP doctors in the area. All VSP doctors accept Sight for Student gift certificates, so the family can pick the doctor that is right for the child.
